

Something Old...

(represents the bride's ties to her family and her past life)

- An Antique brooch or bracelet
- A Pearl necklace belonging to your mother or grandmother
- Pearl or diamond earrings belonging to your mother or your groom's mother
- An Antique ring (worn on the right hand) belonging to a close relative
- Carry something your mother carried down the aisle (a horseshoe, bridal purse, a family bible)

Something New...

(represents the start of a new life and hope for the future)

- Your Bridal Gown
- Your Bridal Shoes
- Your Wedding Jewellery
- Wear a new fragrance (one you haven't worn before that can become your signature fragrance... and a great gift idea for each wedding anniversary)
- New diamond stud earrings (a gift from your generous groom... every time you wear them you will be reminded of your wedding day)

Something Borrowed...

(represents the couple's reliance on family and friends)

- A bible belonging to your groom's family
- A handkerchief belonging to your grandmother or your groom's grandmother
- An item of jewellery from a close relative (earrings, bracelet, brooch)
- Any item from a friend or relative who is happily married so that their good fortune may be passed on to you

Something Blue...

(symbol of purity, faithfulness, loyalty, devotion, everlasting love)

- A garter decorated with blue satin ribbon
- A sapphire or turquoise ring, bracelet or brooch
- A blue handkerchief
- A blue wedding dress
- Blue nail polish on your fingers or toes
- A tiara or hair clip with blue crystals or gemstones
- Blue flowers in your bouquet (hydrangea, hyacinth, cornflower, delphinium)

- A NEW suit, a BORROWED watch and BLUE shoelaces, socks or a blue flower in his buttonhole
